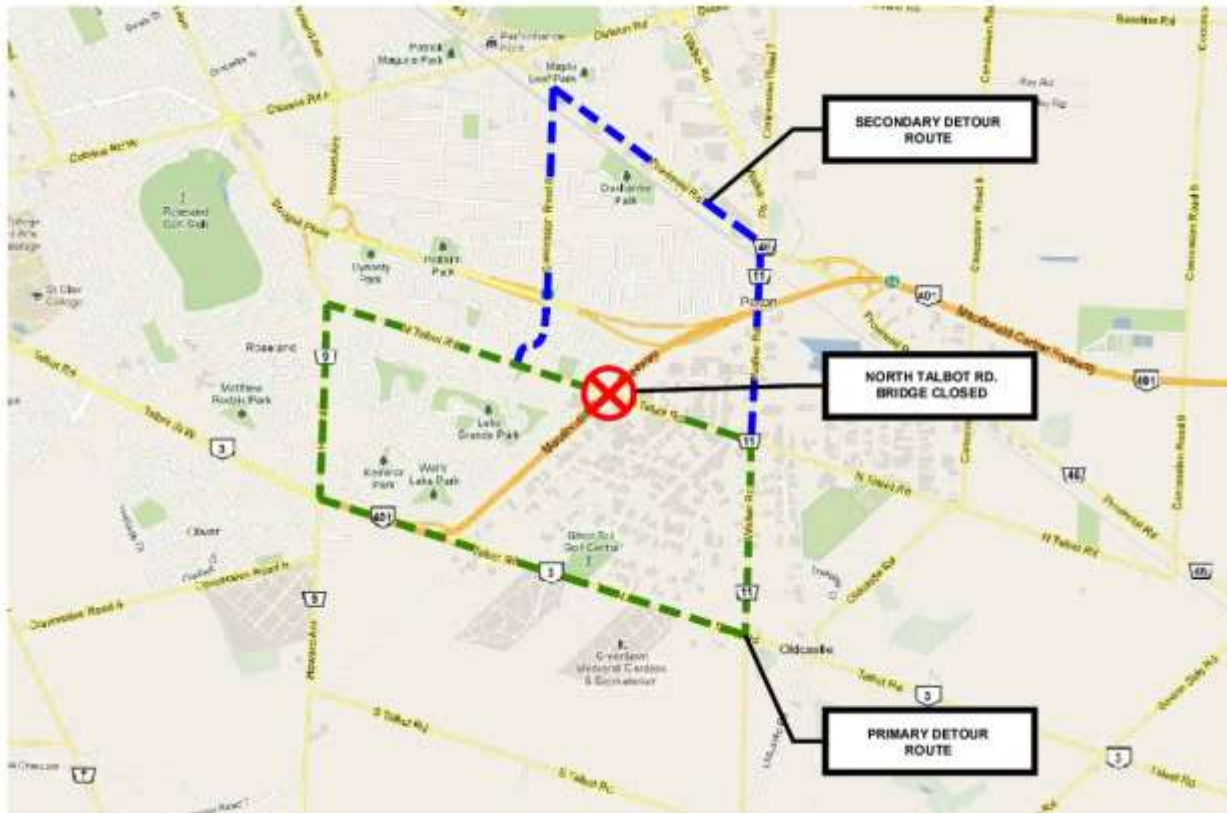


RT. HON. HERB GRAY PARKWAY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NORTH TALBOT ROAD

The North Talbot Road Bridge and portions of North Talbot Road (on each side of the bridge over Highway 401) will be closed beginning Thursday, August 29, 2013. This temporary closure is related to the review of certain concrete girders as part of the Rt. Hon. Herb Gray Parkway.

The Detour Route which follows Howard Avenue, Highway 3 and Walker Road will be used as the primary detour route during the temporary closure. A route via 6th Concession, Provincial Road and Walker Road will also remain available throughout the closure. A map detailing the detour is available on the Parkway website, www.hgparkway.ca.

Pedestrians and cyclists will not be allowed access to the construction area during the closure. Property access will be maintained at all times. Signs will also be in place advising motorists that all access to businesses has been maintained.
